Number Sense and Place Value

Number sense and place value are critical components of 1st grade math standards. At this stage, students develop an understanding of numbers up to 100, learning to recognize, count, and compare quantities. Problem Solving with Addition and Subtraction

Applying addition and subtraction to word problems is an essential part of 1st grade math standards. Students practice solving problems involving situations with unknowns in all positions, which builds critical thinking and analytical skills. These problems often involve everyday contexts to make math meaningful and relevant.

Measurement and Data

Measurement and data are integral aspects of 1st grade math standards that introduce students to quantifying and comparing objects.
