- 1. Scheduled Castes (SC) and Scheduled Tribes (ST): 5 years relaxation, increasing maximum age limit to 37 years.
- 2. Other Backward Classes (OBC): 3 years relaxation, maximum age limit up to 35 years.
- 3. **Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD):** 10 years relaxation for General category, 13 years for OBC, and 15 years for SC/ST.
- 4. **Ex-servicemen:** Up to 5 years relaxation, depending on category and service.
- 5. **Defense personnel disabled in operations:** 3 years relaxation.

These relaxations are strictly enforced, and candidates must produce valid certificates to claim the benefits.

Age Relaxation for Women Candidates

Women candidates are entitled to the same age relaxations as applicable to their respective categories. There is no separate age relaxation solely based on gender.

Additional Eligibility Conditions

Besides educational qualification and age limit, there are other eligibility criteria candidates must fulfill to appear for the IAS exam. These conditions ensure aspirants meet the comprehensive standards expected of civil servants.

Nationality Requirements

IAS exam candidates must be:

- Citizens of India, or
- Subjects of Nepal or Bhutan, or
- Tibetan refugees who came to India before January 1, 1962, intending to settle permanently, or
- Persons of Indian origin who have migrated from countries like Pakistan, Myanmar, Sri Lanka, East African countries, Vietnam, etc., intending to settle permanently in India.

However, candidates from categories other than Indian citizens must produce a certificate of eligibility issued by the Government of India.

Number of Attempts Allowed

The UPSC prescribes a maximum number of attempts for the IAS exam based on the candidate's category:

- General category: 6 attempts.
- OBC category: 9 attempts.
- No limit on attempts for SC/ST candidates up to the age limit.

These restrictions are intended to encourage timely preparation and fair opportunity for all aspirants.

Physical Standards

While there are no strict physical requirements for the IAS exam itself, candidates selected for certain civil services may have to meet specific medical standards during the final stages of recruitment.
