involving descriptive statistics, a two-way ANOVA, and an ANCOVA. No difference was found
between the aggregate eSLOE ratings based on gender, ethnicity, or gender and ethnicity. There
was also no difference in use of communal language based on gender of students when controlling

for total word count. These results contradict prior literature, though it is difficult to determine the reasoning for such findings or if it may be due to one of the studies limitations. Future research should evaluate these findings as a potential temporal or regional trend, address limitations found within this study, and seek to identify reasons for such contradictory findings.
