HISTORY AND MISSION OF THE MCLEOD COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY

THE MCLEOD COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY WAS FOUNDED WITH THE GOAL OF PRESERVING THE UNIQUE HISTORY AND HERITAGE OF MCLEOD COUNTY. SINCE ITS ESTABLISHMENT, THE SOCIETY HAS BEEN COMMITTED TO COLLECTING, SAFEGUARDING, AND INTERPRETING THE HISTORICAL ARTIFACTS, DOCUMENTS, AND STORIES THAT DEFINE THE COUNTY'S PAST. FOUNDING AND DEVELOPMENT
