- OPERATE AT SAFE SPEEDS, ESPECIALLY IN CONGESTED OR NARROW AREAS.
- Use designated aisles and pathways for travel.
- NEVER EXCEED THE RATED LOAD CAPACITY OF THE PALLET JACK.
- ENSURE LOADS ARE STABLE AND BALANCED BEFORE MOVING.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES
