# COMMUNICATION AND NAVIGATION TOOLS

COSTS FOR MOBILE PHONES, GPS DEVICES, AND OTHER COMMUNICATION TOOLS USED FOR BUSINESS PURPOSES ARE DEDUCTIBLE. PROPER ALLOCATION BETWEEN PERSONAL AND BUSINESS USE SHOULD BE MAINTAINED.

- TRUCK WASHES AND CLEANING SUPPLIES
- Union or association dues
- DEPRECIATION OF TRUCK AND EQUIPMENT

# HOW TO CREATE AND USE A TAX DEDUCTION WORKSHEET

### SEPARATING PERSONAL AND BUSINESS EXPENSES

TRUCK DRIVERS MUST DISTINGUISH BETWEEN PERSONAL AND BUSINESS USE OF VEHICLES, DEVICES, AND OTHER EXPENSES. ONLY BUSINESS-RELATED PORTIONS ARE DEDUCTIBLE, REQUIRING CAREFUL ALLOCATION AND DOCUMENTATION.

## ORGANIZING FINANCIAL RECORDS

In addition to receipts and logs, maintaining organized bank and credit card statements helps verify expenses. Using dedicated business accounts can simplify tracking and minimize errors.

# IRS GUIDELINES AND COMPLIANCE FOR TRUCK DRIVER DEDUCTIONS
