Understanding Single Pole Light Switch Basics

Attach the ground wire to the green grounding screw on the switch and the electrical box if it is metal.

Step 5: Secure the Switch and Reinstall Faceplate

Carefully fold the wires back into the electrical box, avoiding sharp bends. Mount the switch to the box using the screws provided. Replace the faceplate and secure it firmly.

Step 6: Restore Power and Test

Turn the power back on at the circuit breaker. Test the switch by toggling it on and off to confirm the light operates correctly. Use a voltage tester if necessary to verify proper voltage at the switch terminals.

Safety Precautions and Best Practices
